Overview

The award-winning HP Universal Print Driver (UPD) revolutionizes print driver management and empowers end users to resolve issues themselves by providing real-time print job and device information. Designed for both enterprise organizations and small and medium-size businesses, a single, intelligent, feature-rich driver replaces many individual drivers making it easy to connect to HP LaserJet and HP Edgeline Technology printing devices without downloading separate, product-specific drivers. Because HP UPD communicates directly with a device, it provides a unique, but familiar, user experience – customized to reflect the attributes of each printer.

Key features and benefits

- New feature provides ability to choose between automatic or manual print queue configuration, allowing for pre-configuration and installation of a queue prior to physically connecting the device to the network
- Option to allow users who do not have administrative rights on their PC to add printers to printer/fax folder
- Improved duplex shortcut and implementation of policies in management tools decrease paper and ink/toner usage
- PIN-less printing forces users to physically retrieve the print job from the printer without having to manage PINs, minimizing waste and contributing to green initiatives
- Advanced separator page feature separates jobs at printer based on user info so the user can quickly identify their document
- HP Web Jetadmin language monitor support integrates into UPD installation package
- Comment field allows for edits to the device name
- Status notification prompts can be enabled or disabled in the “Advanced” tab and are automatically disabled for all domains that have 100 or more user objects
- UPD 4.7 installation option allows multiple UPD versions to exist on the same system helping with driver transition
- New UPD version integrates and aligns functionality with current version, UPD 4.5
